



**THE SHAKEY'S V LEAGUE**  
**2nd Conference - Season 6 (2009)**  
**RULES AND REGULATIONS**



The **SHAKY'S V LEAGUE**, Season 6 (2009), Second Conference shall be governed by the FIVB Official Volleyball Rules. However, as exceptions or addendum to the FIVB Rules, the following specific rules and regulations shall apply to this conference:

**A: PARTICIPATING TEAMS:**

**B: COMPETITION FORMAT:**

**Preliminaries:**

The eight (8) participating teams will play one (1) round. The six (6) teams with the best win-loss records, after the round, will qualify into the quarter-finals.

In the event of a two-way tie for 6th place, the tie will be resolved by a play-off game.

If three or more teams are tied for 6th place, FIVB Rules shall apply to determine the best two which will play-off to resolve the tie.

**Quarter-finals:**

The six (6) qualified teams will play one (1) round. With the win-loss records of the preliminaries carried over into the quarter-finals, the four (4) teams with the best win-loss records, after the round, will qualify into the semi-finals.

In the event of a two-way tie for 4th place, the tie will be resolved by a play-off game.

If three or more teams are tied for 4th place, FIVB Rules shall apply to determine the best two which will play-off to resolve the tie.

**Semi-finals:**

A best-of-three series will be played between the 1st and 4th placed teams of the quarters.

A best-of-three series will be played between the 2nd and 3rd placed teams of the quarters.

**Finals:**

A best-of-three series will be played between the 2 winners of the semis for the gold.

A best-of-three series will be played between the 2 losers of the semis for the bronze.

If the gold medalist is determined in two (2) games, the series for the bronze medal will also end in two (2) games. If the contenders for the bronze are tied after two (2) games, then FIVB Rules will determine the winner.

**C: TEAM COMPOSITION:**

A team shall consist of thirteen (13) players. Twelve (12) of these 13 players shall consist of those players who were or are in the line-up of the team for the current season of their school leagues (i.e., the UAAP, NCAA or WNCAA). The other one (1) shall be a guest player. At the start of each match the coach shall designate the libero for the match.

**D: THE GUEST PLAYERS:**

The guest players may be replaced at any time before the start of the semi-final round of the league. However, starting from the first game of the semi-finals, these players can only be replaced if they are injured to such an extent that they can no longer play for the rest of the league. This injury will have to be validated by the league doctor. Only a total of six (6) guest player replacements will be allowed for the duration of the league.

**E: THE LEAGUE COMMISSIONER:**

The League Commissioner shall have the power to decide on any matter not specifically provided for in these Rules and Regulations.
